Training Offerings

Fundamentals of Project Management

Duration: 8 – 16 hours (Multiple 2 Hrs. Webinar Modules or 1-2 day classroom)

This course deals with the basics of project management. It takes a simple case study and walks the students through all the phases of project management viz. initiation, planning, execution, closing and control.

Tools Used in Project Management

Duration: 2 hours (Webinar)

Tools are essential to manage a project effectively. This course gives the basic overview of the various tools used in project management viz. Gantt chart, EVM, WBS, CPM/ PERT, MS Project (server), Visio. It also familiarizes students with the basic terminologies viz. PMO, Project Charter, ROM, RAID etc.

Advanced Project Management

Duration: 8 – 16 hours (Multiple 2 Hrs. Webinar Modules or 1-2 day classroom)

This course deals with project estimation, risk management, resource allocation, project optimization, project base lining, change management, project reporting, earned value management, after action review critical chain management and other advanced topics.

Setting up PMO Organization

Duration: 8 – 16 hours (Multiple 2 Hrs. Webinar Modules or 1-2 day classroom)

This course deals with how to set up a PMO practice in an organization. The various components of PMO like project governance, project communication, project methodology, multi-project resource management, PM competency model and PM career path are discussed.

Implementing Agile Project Management

Duration: 8 – 16 hours (Multiple 2 Hrs. Webinar Modules or 1-2 day classroom)

Agile project management is a relatively new practice in the industry. It requires a good understanding of the agile concept to implement the practice in the organization. This course deals with concepts like epic, agile estimation (T-Shirt sizing), burn down charts, sprints etc.

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Implementing ITIL Practice

Duration: 8 hours (Multiple 2 Hrs. Webinar Modules or 1 day classroom)

This course deals with the basic terminologies of ITIL. It takes a case study and walks the students through the steps of implementing the ITIL practice in the organization.

Leadership – Day to Day Challenges of a Leader

Duration: 16 hours (Multiple 2 Hrs. Webinar Modules or 2 day classroom)

This is a very interactive course consisting of about 50 role plays that simulate the daily challenges faced by the leader. It allows the leader to make the decision in a safe environment and let them learn by making mistakes.

Social media – A Powerful Tool

Duration: 2 hours (Webinar)

Social media is becoming an essential part of our life for interacting, networking and communicating with the people around the globe. This course demonstrates the different social media tools that can be used by any individual to become more effective in their business and personal life.

Implementing Six Sigma Practice

Duration: 8 – 16 hours (Multiple 2 Hrs. Webinar Modules or 1-2 day classroom)

Six Sigma is a very strong tool for continual process improvement. It is now becoming a very common practice across the industry. This course takes some simple examples to demonstrate how this practice can be implemented in an organization and also how six sigma practices can be customized to the needs of the organization.
